YOUNG @ HEART PERFORMANCE FEE Spring 2011/Summer 2011

\$10,000 fee per 90-minute concert

The fulfillment of all technical requirements (sound, backline, lights, video projection, local labor, etc) as outlined in our Technical Rider is the responsibility of the Presenter. Presenter agrees to meet all terms of the comprehensive technical rider. The rider is an integral part of the agreement and must be fully understood.

The Young@Heart (Y@H) is about 39 people. We will need transportation, food and lodging for chorus and crew.

The Presenter is responsible for round trip flights with baggage and handling feed and ground transportation between airports, hotel and venue. Cost of round trip bus and gratuity are the presenter responsibility. If there is air travel then musical equipment must be provided by the Presenter.

Depending on distance, the Y@H may travel solely by bus. Cost of round trip bus, gratuity, food and lodging for the bus driver are the presenter responsibility.

The Presenter is responsible for feeding (3 meals per day, catering and/or per diem base on GSA standard) the Y@H for our travel and performance days.

The Presenter is responsible for lodging at a minimum of 3 stars hotel. Usually about 27 rooms, both single and two bed rooms. This number can change due to gender of company members on tour and guests.

On a multi-stop tour, it is possible to share the hosting and transportation costs with other presenters. Y@H cannot travel to a new hotel and perform on the same day.

Presenter is responsible for performance rights fees
Y@H will pay on invoice from the Presenter for Guest Costs on tour.

Hosting a company of elderly performers involve some special considerations mostly regarding safety and access to medical care.

There are many more details that form our contract. This is just a general overview.
